Noël Tredinnick

Noël Tredinnick is in demand internationally as an experienced, inspirational orchestral conductor and Christian worship leader. In 1972 he became Conductor & Director of Music at All Souls Church, Langham Place, and from 1975, Professor of Conducting & Orchestral studies at the Guildhall School of Music. Noël directs for BBC TV's *Songs of Praise* and travels world-wide as a musical director and lecturer. He is a Fellow of the Royal School of Church Music and holds a Lambeth Doctorate for services to Church Music.



Heidi Pegler

Heidi Pegler (soprano) studied at the Royal Welsh College of Music and Drama and Trinity College of Music, London. She has performed *Prom Praise* at the Royal Albert Hall, Liverpool Philharmonic Hall, Bridgewater Hall, St David's Hall and the Glasgow Royal Concert Hall. Heidi is Head of Singing at St. Paul's Girls' School, and is an examiner for the ABRSM.



Sarah Stroh

Sarah Stroh (mezzo-soprano) graduated in music studies, both singing and conducting at Hull University, and is a prize-winning postgraduate of the Royal Academy of Music. She has been soloist for many major oratorios, teaching singing at St. Paul's Girls' School and London School of Theology. She also conducts and directs the award-winning ladies' choir, *Jubilate*.



Stuart Overington

Stuart Overington (tenor) is a graduate from the Royal Northern College of Music. Whilst at the college he had the opportunity to perform a wide range of operatic and choral repertoire. He now works as a vocal tutor and coach with various choirs across the north-west and continues to perform regularly.



Peter Barber

Peter Barber (baritone) developed his love of oratorio, opera and musical theatre while at Oxford University. He went on to study at Guildhall School of Music and has sung many major bass-baritone roles including *Messiah* and *Requiems* by Mozart, Faure, Brahms and Verdi as well as the title roles in *The Flying Dutchman* and *The Marriage of Figaro*.



John Langley

John Langley (Voice of God) has sung with the Royal Philharmonic, the BBC Concert and All Souls Orchestras and at Glasgow Royal Concert Hall. He performs regularly with three touring shows, the close harmony group *Cabinet Shuffle* and his own new touring concert *Movies and Musicals*. West End credits include *Phantom of the Opera*, *Whistle down the Wind* and *Mamma Mia*.
